

The pointing and versatile breeds work with their handlers and owners to hunt upland game as well as waterfowl. They also work in recovery of other game.

These dogs are trained and tested in their cooperation, use of nose, pointing ability, obedience, steadiness, tracking and game recovery. The versatile abilities of these dogs also enables them to be genuine partners in conservation.

Members come together through the spring and summer to train their dogs during group training days. The comradery of the training days leads to lifelong friendships between members and the training connections go far between the scheduled training days.

Dogs and owners from the club, not only test in the NAVHDA test stream, but can also be found in CKC pointing events, American Field trials, other dog sports, out hunting during hunting season, guiding, and as family companions.

While training is focused on the pointing and versatile breeds, the club welcomes members from anyone with an interest in training a hunting dog.

White Fish with Creamy Creole Sauce

For the Fish:

4 fillets

2 tbsp olive oil

1 tsp paprika

1 tsp garlic powder

1 tsp onion powder

½ tsp cayenne pepper

Salt and pepper to taste

For the Creamy Creole Sauce:

2 tbsp unsalted butter

1 small onion, finely chopped

1 green bell pepper, finely chopped

2 celery stalks, finely chopped

2 cloves garlic, minced

1 cup heavy cream

½ cup chicken broth

2 tbsp garlic infused honey

1 can (14.5 oz) diced tomatoes, drained

1 tsp Creole seasoning

½ tsp thyme

1/4 tsp cayenne pepper

Salt and pepper to taste

2 tbsp fresh parsley, chopped

1 tbsp lemon juice



DIRECTIONS:

Preheat your oven to 375°F (190°C).

Prepare the fish: In a small bowl, mix together paprika, garlic powder, onion powder, cayenne pepper, salt, and pepper. Rub this mixture evenly over both sides of the red snapper fillets.

Heat the olive oil in a large oven-safe skillet over medium-high heat. Add the fillets and cook for about 3 minutes on each side until golden brown. Transfer the skillet to the preheated oven and bake for an additional 8-10 minutes, or until the fish is cooked through and flakes easily with a fork.

Prepare the creamy Creole sauce: In a large saucepan, melt the unsalted butter over medium heat. Add the chopped onion, green bell pepper, and celery. Cook until the vegetables are softened, about 5-7 minutes. Add the minced garlic and cook for another minute.

Stir in the heavy cream, chicken broth, garlic infused honey and diced tomatoes. Add the Creole seasoning, thyme, cayenne pepper, salt, and pepper. Bring to a simmer and cook for about 10 minutes, stirring occasionally, until the sauce thickens.

Remove the sauce from heat and stir in the chopped fresh parsley and lemon juice.

Serve the fillets topped with the creamy Creole sauce. Garnish with additional fresh parsley if desired.
